#### Dear Parishioner,

This weekend we celebrate the Palm Sunday and begin the Holy Week - a journey of sacred remembrance and profound reflection. Holy Week is the most sacred time in the liturgical year. It is a time of blessing and a time of cherishing God's salvation for us all. This is not just a week of rituals, but a time to enter more deeply into the heart of Jesus' sacrifice for us

Palm Sunday reminds us of His triumphal entry into Jerusalem, yet this joy was fleeting. Holy Week reveals the depths of His suffering, from the betrayal of the Last Supper to His agonizing crucifixion. Let us walk with Him in spirit through each of these profound events.

Let us make time for prayer, silence, and acts of service as a way of honouring our Lord's path. Let this Holy Week be our journey alongside Him, as we prepare for the glorious celebration of Easter and His resurrection.

Family Palms: Thank you for nurturing your family palm, a symbol of the connection within our parish community. May the Lord's peace and joy flourish in your homes as your palm grows.

**Holy week confessions [Monday at 6.30pm]:** The Sacrament of Reconciliation (or Confession) offers us the profound gift of God's forgiveness and unconditional love. Several priests will be available for confessions in our parish. Please prepare your hearts and make use of this opportunity as you ready yourself for the Paschal Feast.

Let us share the blessings of Holy Week by inviting our family and friends to join us in celebrating this sacred time.

Full Day Adoration at Holy Cross: During this Holy Week, let us spend more time with the Lord in prayer. On Tuesday, there will be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in our church after the morning Mass until 5pm.

Chrism Mass at the Cathedral: During Holy Week, we will celebrate the Chrism Mass at the Cathedral with our Archbishop, bishops, priests, and the faithful of our diocese. During this Mass, the bishop blesses the oils—the oil of catechumens (oleum catechumenorum or oleum sanctorum), the oil of the infirm (oleum infirmorum) and holy chrism (sacrum chrisma) — which will be used in the administration of the sacraments throughout the diocese for the year. Please join us for this year's Chrism Mass on Wednesday, 27 March 2024, at 11.30am in our Cathedral. Address: Cathedral House, Westminster Bridge Road, London SE1 7HY.

The Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday begins at 7pm: During this Mass, we will celebrate the institution of the Holy Eucharist and the sacrament of Holy Orders. On this sacred day, the Lord gave us the New Commandment to love one another as He has loved us. The washing of the feet, a powerful symbol of service and humility, will take place after the homily.

Good Friday Service begins at 3pm: On Good Friday, we solemnly remember the sacrifice Jesus made for our salvation. It is a day for prayer, fasting, and quiet reflection on Christ's Passion. Let us join together on Good Friday to walk the sorrowful path with Jesus, reflecting on His boundless love.
